**Requirement:** Must be 18 years or older. Students must provide four patients who are available to receive pit and fissure sealants service during class time.

## **PIT & FISSURE SEALANTS CLASS**

### **DESCRIPTION:**

This Pit & Fissure Sealant Class meets the Dental Board of California requirement for the Registered Dental Assistants (RDA) licensure. This course includes theory, preclinical (manikin practice), and clinical (patient) components.

Students will gain experience in a variety of coronal polishing techniques. Students will need to provide and successfully complete a coronal polish procedure on three patients.

### **PREREQUISITES:**

Students must provide the following, **TWO WEEKS BEFORE** the start of the first class. Failure to do so will render the student ineligible and will not be permitted in the class.

- Valid Dental Infection Control Certificate
- Valid Dental Practice Act Certificate
- Valid Dental Radiation Safety Certificate
- Valid Dental Coronal Polishing Certificate
- Valid BLS Certificate

### **CLINICAL PATIENT REQUIREMENT:**

- The clinical portion of the course will require each student to bring in three (4) patients to receive a full mouth coronal polish.
- All patient's will be done at Eden Area ROP, and will be scheduled with the instructor at the first class session.
- Patients cannot have removable or fixed dentures.
- Patients must be 18 years or older.

### **WRITTEN EXAMINATION:**

A written examination will be administered after the presentation of the theory content. Students must pass this exam with at least 75% in order to begin the lab or clinical components.

### **MATERIALS :**

Students are to wear scrubs and closed-toed non-slip shoes to all class sessions. Protective eyewear is to be provided by the student and worn for all clinical procedures. All other materials and supplies will be provided by the Eden Area ROP.
